- (1) Late application fee will be triple the fee of the original application cost.
- (2) Escrow: Applicants are required to escrow the indicated amount of money with the Township and sign an escrow agreement. Applicants are responsible for fully reimbursing the Township for all professional costs it incurs related to the request. The Township uses the escrowed funds to reimburse itself for these costs and if the escrow is not sufficient to fully reimburse the Township the applicant will be billed or required to submit additional funds to be placed in escrow. Any unreimbursed amounts constitute a service charge the Township will certify to the County Auditor for collection on the applicant's property as provided in Minn. Stat. § 366.012.
