Completed Work

- Final maintenance grading was done on various Town roads for 2025
- All major projects have been completed for 2025
- Snow plowing and salting operations



A winter storm produced heavy snow, strong winds, and blizzard conditions across our area from Tuesday November 26 through Thanksgiving, Thursday November 27. The storm began as a mix of rain and snow during the day Tuesday, transitioning to all snow Tuesday evening. Snowfall rates of over one inch per hour occurred with strong winds gusting to 40 to 50 mph causing blowing snow to reduce visibility and leading to drifting snow even well after the snow ended on Wednesday morning. In preparation for this weather event (which had a strong resemblance of the December 2022 storm), I contacted multiple competent trusted contractors on Tuesday evening and had them all on notice. At about 03:00 I was in contact with our snow plowing contractor Gregory Waldhalm Utility and Excavating. Ryan and I discussed the plan, and they dispatched to find many downed or bent trees over the roads. Ryan and his crew were ready with chain saws to get the roads opened. This was a difficult task with all the heavy wet snow, unfrozen roads, and windy conditions; however, they persevered and got it done. A little later in the morning I dispatched Valhalla Tree service. Andy sent out 2 crews to start in on all remainder bent and down trees in the ROW. It was critical to get this done before it got worse, not only for the safety of the public, but that of the contractors maintaining the roads. The mission was accomplished!

To set the record straight Ryan and his crew did not widen the very soft gravel roads. They kept the blade up a couple inches to create a hard pack on the gravel roads to in turn preserve the gravel.

To set the record straight Ryan and his crew did not widen the very soft gravel roads for a reason, and here is why. They kept the blade up a couple inches to create a hard pack on the gravel roads. They left a berm on the edge of the shoulder for the same reasons. We did not want to plow the gravel in the ditches which has been done some years ago prior to my involvement as road manager. All in all, this plan worked very well! I appreciate Ryan and his crew for doing an excellent job!

Some of the issues they ran into were private citizens plowing public roads. The main example was Heppner Road. This was done by a resident in that area, and it created problems for the Ryan and his crew. That resident that was plowing Heppner left a pile of wet heavy snow on Military Road. This in turn caused issues for other drivers trying to avoid this soon the be hard pile of slushy snow. The bottom line is private residents are not to be plowing the public roads per

MN Statute 160.2715 RIGHT-OF-WAY USE; MISDEMEANORS.

(a) Except for the actions of the road authorities, their agents, employees, contractors, and utilities in carrying out their duties imposed by law or contract, and except as herein provided, it shall be unlawful to:

(1) obstruct any highway or deposit snow or ice thereon;

We ask the public do not plow the public roads or leave any snow or debris in the ROW. This only cause issues for driver and the contractors to be able to do the jobs effectively and efficiently.
